The grand prize is \$3,000.00 + a trip to the 2010 Professional Lighting Designers Association (PLDA) workshop (location to be announced, airfare and accommodation included). There will be also two runner-up awards. Online applications are due **February 23, 2009** in order to reserve a spot. **Entries and judging will take place on March 4, 2009.** Selected submissions, including the three winners, will be on display during a two-day exhibit.
